Minutes of the Argyle Free Library Board of Trustees

July 15, 2015

The meeting was called to order at 7:07 PM by President Remus Preda.

Members present: Julie Gann, Martha Johnson, Carol Kuhr, Remus Preda, Amy Stott and Robert Webster. Catrina Scott-Becker was also attending.

Minutes of the May 21 meeting were approved.

The Treasurer's report was presented by Bob Webster (see attached). Bob reported that he has purchased a \$25,000 CD to replace a \$15,000 CD coming due. He will renew another \$25,000 CD in October, for 5 years, with a higher interest rate over 1%. Our July 4 book sale netted \$581.

New Business

- <u>Board of Trustees Treasurer</u>: Due to Bob's travel schedule, it is necessary to appoint an Interim Treasurer through May 2016. A motion was made and approved to appoint Catrina Scott-Becker to the Board of Trustees. A motion was made and approved to appoint Catrina Scott-Becker Interim Treasurer through May 2016. A motion was made and approved to accept Robert Webster's resignation from the Board, effective August 15. Bob requests to be reinstated upon his return in May 2016. Bob will write the October fund raising letter. A motion was made and approved to purchase Quicken, for installation on Catrina's computer, if necessary.
- **Book Sale**: There was a discussion of the book sale and it's success, noting that \$160 of the profit came from the sale of popcorn and lemonade. Instead of having a book sale, there may be other ways to participate in the town's July Fourth celebrations. We will reconsider our plans for next year at a later date.
- **Book Culling**: The removal of our dusty books is proceeding slowly. Bob will speak to Sue McWhorter about scheduling RSVP volunteers to pull books from the shelves. We will consider selling the books at a special book sale in October.

<u>Old Business</u>

• June Meeting with Sara Dallas and Laurie Buckley: There was a discussion of last month's meeting with SALS Sara Dallas and Laurie Buckley. Informational material is circulating among Board members. Amy Stott is interested in visiting other libraries recommended by Sara. We need to start planning to upgrade our bathroom to meet disability codes.

Our next meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, August 18, 2015.
